- In addition to participating in five Seven Lag Zoom meetings this summer, Agderlag will have a membership meeting, yet to be scheduled. The first Seven Lag+ meeting will be on May 15 with a presentation by Terje Joranger on the history of Syttende Mai. In the afternoon we will have videos of Syttende Mai celebrations in small Norwegian communities.

- The past year with COVID we have not had any in-person events but our Board has met regularly via Zoom.
- We have 260 paid members (including 5 in Canada and 4 in Norway), and 25 organizations. We had 67 renewals and 22 new members. We mail 280 copies of our Brev newsletter 3 times/year.
- Our Facebook page saw a significant increase in activity the past two years. We have 818
 members. Facebook has allowed us to connect with our members and nonmembers, which in
 turn has resulted in many new members.
- We are looking forward to our still-scheduled (as of this writing) Tre Lag Stevne. And in 2022,
 Tre Lag will be adding two additional Lags with a new name soon to be announced.

I'm saddened to report the passing of two of our long-time board members. Jim Olson, long time President, passed away March 13th. Jim served on our Board and then as our President for 12 years and led many Lag trips to Norway. Two weeks later we lost Betty Strand who served on the Board in a number of different roles for nearly 25 years. Both Jim and Betty were fixtures at the Tre Lag Stevne.
