The event starts with coffee at 9:15 a.m. so that people have a chance to greet one another.

Greetings and national anthems will begin about 9:35 a.m. followed by the business meeting.

Special guests will be introduced as we celebrate the activities and the recent history of the Fellesraad. A sense of our collective heritage will be included in the program portion of the meeting prior to lunch at noon.

Former Fellesraad board members are being invited to share something about the times in which they served as part of our cultural program. Pictures will be taken.

A delegate should represent one lag and indicate which one on the registration form (left). Non-delegates attending register as "guests" and they may list one or more lag in which they hold membership.

Each group in good standing may seat two delegates. This condition means that annual lag dues of \$5 and any other projects agreed upon at the previous meeting have been paid. (more, p. 2) Mainly, delegates hear reports and vote in the business meeting, which includes the annual election of officers.

Proposed agenda items should be sent to the president by April 15.

Nominations for one open position on the board may be mailed to Secretary Sonia Rache by April 15. Each candidate must have been asked if they are willing to serve (if elected) before placing their name in nomination, giving the lag/s in which they hold membership. Terms of office are one year. Celebrating Ibsen and 90 Years As A National Lag Council

Norwegian dramatist Henrik Ibsen is being celebrated worldwide especially this year because his plays introduced social problems and dared to speak about them. They are still pertinent today, 100 years after his death. The Commonweal Theatre, Lanesboro, does an Ibsen play each year. "Ghosts" was a Theatre-in-the Round production earlier in 2006.

Founded in 1916, the Fellesraad will hold its 90th annual meeting May 6.

Much has happened since the 1899 Valdres meeting. In 2007 the Telelag and the Hallinglag will also have 100th anniversaries.

In seeking to promote each of the bygdelag, we do what we can to link Americans to a lag or lags where they have ancestry. It is fantastic to learn about the local and regional variations in food and language and dressing traditions. And superb when we find connecting relatives and the churches and landscape known to our ancestors.

Congratualtions this year to our 95th anniversary lag: Hardanger, Sigdal, and Sunnhordland, now a part of Nordhordland which organized in 1913. Ringerike Drammen's origins began 90 years ago.

Last year we celebrated Norway's 1905 centennial as an independent nation.

In 1914 the Norway celebrated the centennial of its Constitution Day, May 17, 1814. Many people in North America wanted to send gifts, even if some crossed the Atlantic by ship to attend in person. This held true for many bygdelag who had organized by then. Prominent members in various states had raised funds for use in their home bygd or district.

In 1916 the organization of a "lag for all of the lag" became a reality. It became acceptable after the multiple presentations of many gifts to Norwegian kommuner or fylker (local or county/state government units) from America. And the artistry of many lag banners as reciprocal gifts from Norway continues to be enjoyed.

Earlier attempts for a council of bygdelag groups had been debated and approved, but no action had taken place.

Because Stavangerlag observed the 1825-1925 anniversary of the arrival of the "Sloopers", its leadership invited every bygdelag and church college bands and choirs and other organizations to celebrate in Minneapolis. It became a great showcase of the success Norwegian immigrants and their children had attained in the "new country."

When the event was over, the profits were given to Bygdelagenes Fellesraad, provided that the group be incorporated in the state of Minnesota. It was incorporated in 1926. It is why the investments held by the Fellesraad are treated as endowment funds.

The board and its treasurer plan an annual budget and the board does its best to live within its income-- dues from member groups, dividends and interest.

Bygdelagenes Fellesraad MINUTES 89th Annual Meeting May 7, 2005

The Annual Meeting of Bygdelagenes Fellesraad was held May 7, 2005 at Mindekirken in Minneapolis, Minnesota. President Marilyn Somdahl called the meeting to order at 9:30 AM and welcomed everyone to the 89th Annual Meeting of Bygdelagenes Fellesraad.

The National Anthems of both the United States and Norway were sung, accompanied by Diane Lerohl.

Pastor Jens Dale of Mindekirken welcomed everyone to the church. He stated that Mindekirken is celebrating its 75th anniversary this year. Pastor Dale also said his family is returning to Norway this summer after three years in Minnesota. He invited everyone to attend the worship service June 7, 2005 to celebrate the 100th anniversary of Norway's independence from Sweden. He also invited everyone to attend various concerts coming to Mindekirken in May and June.

Roll Call - Secretary Sonia Rache called the roll for each bygdelag. The following lags had delegates: Gudbrandsdal (2), Hadeland (2), Hallinglag (2), Hardander (1), Landingslag (2), Møre og Romsdal (1), Nordfjord (2), North Hedmark og Hedemarken (2), Nordhordland (1), Nordlandslag (2), Ringerike-Drammen (2), Rogaland (2), Romerikslag (2), Sigdalslag (2), Sognalag (2), Solør Lag (1), Sunnfjord (2), Sunnhordland (1), Telelag (2), Toten (1), Trønderlag (2), Valdres Samband (2), and Vestlandslag (1).

The delegates were asked to introduce themselves and tell of any special anniversary plans or planned trips to Norway. (List attached)

Secretary's Report - A motion was made, seconded and carried to accept the Secretary's report of the May 1, 2004, meeting as printed in Bygdelagenes Fellesraad's BULLETIN.

Treasurer's Report - The audited Treasurer's report for April 30, 2005, was presented by R. Lee Brown, treasurer, along with a copy of the budget for the year 5/1/04 to 4/30/05. The Treasurer's report of April 30, 2005, shows a checking account balance of \$ 3, 067.45 and total (paper) assets of \$71, 305.31. The audit was prepared by Leland Pandall.

A **motion** was made to accept the financial reports as presented. The motion was seconded and carried. (Copy of financial report, budget and audit are attached).

Elections - The following slate of officers was read by Sonia Rache, secretary, and placed in nomination for the next year: President, Marilyn Somdahl, Vice President, Marilyn Sorensen, Treasurer, R. Lee Brown, Secretary, Sonia Rache, Director, Bruce Boyce, Webmaster/Director, EuGene Rodi

Vice President Marilyn Sorensen called for nominations from the floor. There being none, a **motion** was made to close nominations and accept the slate as presented. The motion was seconded and carried.

Reports - Webmaster Gene Rodi reported the web site has new features. A PDF file is now available. He stated that the most recent brochure is downloadable online. (Reports, continued)- There are also other forms available for use online. He requested that all information and changes to sites be sent to him so the sites can be kept up to date. You can get to all other lag sites from the www.fellesraad.com site.

Vice President Marilyn Sorensen spoke briefly on genealogy. She stated that genealogy really keeps us connected to Norway. She asked delegates to check with their lag genealogists to see if they would like to get together to discuss needs, training or other Fellesraad assistance. If so, please contact Marilyn Sorensen.

Marilyn Somdahl, president, said her report was printed in the April 2005 newsletter, which was sent to all lags. Marilyn reminded everyone to let her know if lag officers (past or present) pass away during the year so we can send the family a memorial.

Norway House continues to raise money from large contributors for a proposed house in Minneapolis. She also said Norway: Portrait of a Nation, which retails for \$129 plus tax, is available to each bygdelag and delegates for \$99 plus tax (\$103.95).

She reminded each lag to keep the Fellesraad president informed of activities and contacts so the brochure and advertising information can be kept up to date.

New Business - A review of the ad in Viking Magazine was conducted. The negatives were misspellings in the headings, but they multiply when the ad is copied. Also, is the ad cost productive? The positives are that the ad is copied and used by other groups. It may also be good for small lags to get their names out that don't have a big marketing budget. All lag information was correct.

A **motion** was made to proceed with the same ad for next year and charge \$15.00 per lag. January 15th is the date for information to be submitted. The motion was seconded and carried.

It was recommended that all lags poll their membership to see if they think the Sons of Norway ad is productive.

There was no further business.

Announcements - Bob O'Neil, president of the Norwegian American Genealogy Association, invited everyone to attend their meetings the last Wednesday evening of each month at their Golden Valley location.

Mary Jo Thorsheim invited everyone to view the 1905 posters she has on display.

Lag Anniversaries and Trips Hadeland, Land, Møre og Romsdal, Rogaland, Solør and Toten are celebrating their 95th anniversaries this year.

Romerikslag and North Hedmark og Hedemarken are each **celebrating 10**th **anniversaries**.

Gudbrandsdal, Hadeland, Land, Nordfjord and Nordfjord-WI, Trønderlag, Voss and Sognefjord are planning **2005 trips** to Norway.

The business meeting was adjourned at 11 AM.
